EVERYONE ATTENDING GROUND	Player, coach, or match official arrives while unwell and transmits virus to surfaces or someone else.	We will use a temperature gun to take temperature of all participants entering the ground. On Training and Match Days, this includes away teams. Details of temperature will be logged with details of all participants for track and trace purposes. Isolation will be recommended.	We will be in frequent contact with players and officials, who will be aware of their requirements to adhere to protocols and protect others.
TEAMS ATTENDING	Controlling how people get to the ground during match days.	We have advised everyone to follow government guidelines when travelling to the ground.	Managers to outline to players every week.
TEAMS TRACK AND TRACE	Contracting COVID-19 after a confirmed case has been reported.	We will advise and keep full track and trace records for 21 days.	
TEAMS ACCESSING GROUND	Equipment in frequent use: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Goalposts - Corner Flags - Balls - Gloves - Bottles - Kit 	All teams have been advised to ensure all equipment is kept clean and not shared. Hand sanitiser stations have been set up around the ground along with signage.	

<p>PLAYERS AREAS HOME & AWAY</p>	<p>Players mixing together upon entering the ground.</p> <p>People exposed to Covid 19 by touching door handles, light switches in frequent use</p>	<p>Players are to enter via a one way labelled system into the ground via the main gate. One way should be used when entering all playing corridors and should keep to the left in situations where it is not possible to have segregation.</p> <p>Antibacterial spray has been supplied at stations for handles and light-switches.</p> <p>All members must be responsible for washing hands on a regular basis.</p>	<p>Signs installed where required and hand sanitiser.</p>
<p>CHANGING ROOMS</p>	<p>Mixing together before and after game</p>	<p>HOME changing Room is large enough to accommodate 20 Players as very large. Doors and any ventilation.</p> <p>AWAY Changing Room – Max 13 People Doors and vents to be open where possible</p>	
<p>SHOWERS</p>	<p>Showering After Game</p>	<p>We would currently advise players where possible not to shower after games. However in conditions where this is required:</p> <p>HOME: Private Showers 3 Max at any one time – ones that are not to be used marked up.</p> <p>AWAY: Larger Showers communal, 4 Max at any one time.</p> <p>REFS: Have one private shower. No Risk.</p>	<p>Ensure Signage in place</p>

COMMUNAL SPACES	Teams lining up, Passing, Refs etc	Home area segregated from Away – Teams will go out by two exits – Home Door and Away Door onto Pitch. They will not line up together. Areas will be signed to ensure people walk on the Left at all times.	
TOILETS - PUBLIC	Multiple people entering.	Maximum of 2 people per toilet – this has been signed and hand sanitiser and foot-controlled bins with disposable paper towels.	
CLUB HOUSE	Multiple people entering. Multiple people sitting in areas. General cleanliness	Tables have been set to specified distances. They may NOT be moved. Bar area has also been set with designated areas for serving whilst keeping social distancing. Stairs labelled to keep to the left at all times when going up or coming down.	
BALCONY	Social distancing on Balcony	12 Maximum will be allowed on the balcony Social distancing must be followed at all times. Signage applied. Staff will ask people to vacate the Balcony if this is higher than the permitted 12.	
DRINKS	Cleanliness of cutlery / glass	We are only using disposable cups for Alcoholic Drinks or Cans. Glasses will NOT be used for the foreseeable future. Food is no served currently.	Plan for when food is available.
